

Peach Stone Shell

The closest equivalent to apricot kernel shell; a strong biomass fuel that gives dense embers and burns for a long time thanks to its high gross calorific value.

Peach Kernel Shell is the thick, woody shell left over after the hard kernels of peaches processed in juice and concentrate factories are cracked and the oil/aroma-bearing core is removed; it is physically quite similar to apricot kernel shell.
